We are interested in what you value, your goals, and your commitment to the profession. Your application will only be viewed by a small committee who is bound by privacy and confidentiality laws in higher education.

Motivation for social service, social work education, and a career in the profession. Describe why you want to pursue professional social work education; any particular reason for applying to this University; social service interests and career goals.

Elaborate on your particular strengths, skills and abilities that you feel would add to your success in this profession. Identify your biggest challenges.
