Keynote Speaker

Brad Lane, O.D., MBA, M.Ed.



Brad Lane, O.D., MBA, M.Ed., is a Wyoming County native, growing up in Mullens, W.Va., and is a proud son of a West Virginia coal miner. He earned undergraduate degrees in psychology, sociology and pre-professional biology from the honors program at Concord University in Athens, W.Va. He graduated from the Pennsylvania College of Optometry with a Doctorate of Optometry in 2007. He then joined Dr. Hansen

as a practice owner of Appalachian Eye Care. In 2016, he completed work earning an MBA and in 2020, he earned a Masters of Education in Instructional Design.

Lane is a staunch advocate for his profession and serves on many boards that seek to advance optometry, eye health and patient care. He is a frequent contributor to AOA Focus Magazine and the past co-chair of the American Optometric Association's Education Committee. He has also served on the AOA Federal Legislative and Health Promotion Committees. He is a past president of the West Virginia Association of Optometric Physicians. Currently, he serves as a treasurer to the Southern Education Congress of Optometry (SECO) based in Atlanta and a board member of the Optometry Cares Foundation. Lane is also a diplomate of the American Board of Optometry and was honored as the West Virginia Young Optometric Physician of the Year in 2013 and Optometric Physician of the Year in 2017.

Lane is also committed to his community and is vice chairman of the Concord University Board of Governors, a founding member of Concord University's White Coat Society and has created and funded three scholarships. In 2013, he was honored as the Concord University Young Alumnus of the Year and as the Concord University Philanthropist of the Year in 2021. In 2022, he was named the Concord University Alumnus of the Year. He also serves on the board of Riding for a Cure Foundation, a local charity that raises money to transport women battling breast cancer.
